Declaration of Conflict Minerals

Our company places great importance on corporate social responsibility and supply chain management. We are committed to ensuring that our outsourced components and raw materials comply with international Human Rights Law. Our company is committed to procure minerals that are “non-conflict minerals”, and we ensure procured minerals are NOT originating from conflict-affected areas that are associated with armed conflict, human rights abuses, or illegal mining activities.

For the purpose of this statement, conflict minerals refer to minerals originating from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and its adjoining countries, including Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, Republic of the Congo, Uganda, Sudan, Tanzania, Rwanda, and Zambia. These minerals include Tin (Sn), Tantalum (Ta), Tungsten (W), Gold (Au), Cobalt (Co), Mica, Copper (Cu), Natural Graphite, Lithium (Li), and Nickel (Ni).

Our company adopts the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) issued by the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) and we Due Diligently ensure our supply chain to fulfill the following responsibilities:

1. Do not use conflict minerals originating from conflict-affected regions.
2. Conduct reasonable due diligence to verify the sources of raw materials.
3. Cooperate with our company in conflict minerals investigations and provide relevant information when required.

Our company will continue to work with supply chain partners to establish a transparent and responsible supply chain management, and fulfill social responsibility by disclosing necessary information/declarations regarding the sources of minerals.
